<p&gt;The connection between Paris Saint-Germain and the city&#39;s fashion h ouses &#128077; is a longstanding one. French fashion designer Daniel Hechter b ecame PSG president in 1973 and designed the club&#39;s traditional home &#128077; look that same year: a blue shirt with a red vertical stripe flanked by two thinner white stripes (blue-white-red-white-blue).[115][117] First &#128077; wo rn in the 1973 74 season, the so-called &quot;Hechter shirt&quot; has remained the classic home identity of PSG ever since.[118][119][120]&lt;/p&gt; &lt;p&gt;The general &#128077; belief is that Hechter based his creation on the red-and-white jersey worn by Ajax, the dominant team in Europe at &#128077; the time, but with the French flag in mind.[13][115][117] Hechter himself has denied this, though, instead claiming he was inspired &#128077; by the Ford Mustang. He transposed the car&#39;s hood stripes on the shirt and employed the three colours of the &#128077; club.[115] The Hechter shirt has two alternate versions: the &quot;reversed Hechter&quot; (red-white-blue-white-red), introduced in the 1974 75 season, and the &quot;white &#128077; Hechter&quot; (white-blue-red-bl) Tj T\*

<p&qt;PSG, however, split from PFC in 1972 and thus needed a new crest. &#128 077; Representing both Paris and Saint-Germain-en-Laye, the club's second c rest became the basis of the one the fans know today. The 👍 round logo featured the Eiffel Tower in red against a blue background and, underneath it, t wo Saint-Germain symbols in white: 👍 a fleur de lys and Louis XIV's cradle.[125] Created by Christian Lentretien, former PSG board member and publi cist by profession, 👍 this crest was first used in 1972 and lasted unti I 1982.[125][126] The Parc des Princes, the club's home stadium, appeared &# 128077; below it between 1982 and 1990.[125]</p&gt; <p&gt;Paris Saint-Germain played their first game at their current home stadi um, the 47,929-seater Parc des 👍 Princes, against Lique 2 promotion riv als Red Star on 10 November 1973.[21][132] It was the curtain-raiser for that se ason's opening 👍 Lique 1 match between Paris FC and Sochaux.[21] PS G moved into the ground upon its return to Ligue 1 in 👍 1974, ironicall y the same year that Paris FC were relegated.
